

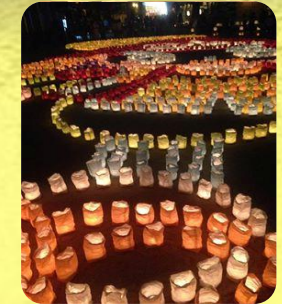
# AUTUMN COURSE 2019

- **Nokonoshima Cosmos** - Join us on a trip to nearby Nokonoshima Island (just a 10-minute ferry ride from Fukuoka) to see the spectacular cosmos in full bloom, as well as sunset views.

- **Hakata Tomyo Watching**- Join us as we go to the Hakata neighborhood to see the Paper Lantern Festival - streets lit up with paper lanterns as far as the eye can see!
- **Fukuoka Oktoberfest** - This beer festival is known and loved by German culture (and beer) lovers around the world. Come join us for Fukuoka's take on this fall classic!
- **Momijigari** - Japanese culture places great importance on the changing of the seasons and on fleeting moments. One such example, momijigari, or viewing the autumn leaves as they change color, is a classic fall tradition.
